

Sunday, February 11, 2024, Workshop with Joanna Figueroa

Workshop: Plumeria Where: Orange Quilt Bee, 626 E. Katella Ave. in Orange Time: 10 am — 4 pm Cost: \$40

To kick off the new year, we present Joanna Figueroa who will be teaching her newest pattern, "Plumeria."

"Plumeria" is a versatile pattern with two different size blocks and three pattern variations. You can make a large block from your favorite fat quarters, or a smaller block out of a Dessert Roll, as well as a two-color variation shown here in red and white. Or you could make a table runner, a small wall hanging, or a quilt.

Things you will learn:

- Sew and Flip Method and when to use it and why.
- Choosing fabrics and the various ways to go about that.



The fabrics will not be the same as her sample because they will not be available until April, but they will be similar. The price of the kits has not been determined at this time. 


Little Red Hen is Coming March 11, 2024

What is a UFO? You had purchased the pattern and the fabrics to get started but never got around to get it started. It's that partially completed top that you started at a class but haven't finished. It's a finished top that still needs to be quilted. It could even be that quilt that just needs binding and a label, but it's been sitting around a while waiting for you to make them.

Looking for ways to finish your UFO quilt projects? Look no further, we have the solutions for you. Sign up for the UFO Challenge which runs from May 2023 to April 2024 and a \$10.00 fee at our next Guild Meeting to get started. See the attached handout and sign-up sheet.

When you sign up, we have a beautiful ribbon for you to pin on to your name tag. You will receive one of the five buttons for each project completed that you have signed up for. I think I got sidetracked as I began with the intention of looking at gratitude. I have so much to be grateful for:


